HASS AVOCADO

General Characteristics

Also known by its scientific name, *Persea Americana*.

Avocado is fruit and vegetable at the same time. With a soft and exquisite hazelnut flavor, with a tender and creamy consistency, they can be combined with any type of food. It originally comes from the tropical and subtropical areas of Central America.



It is a pear-shaped fruit, although it can also be shaped like a cucumber or an apple, its skin is dark, rough and thick, the tone and texture change from one variety to another. It has a creamy yellow pulp that covers a large inedible brown seed, its size varies between 7 to 33 cm long and up to 15 cm wide, it does not have an intense or defined flavor, it may have notes of fruit dry as walnut or hazelnut. However, the flavor of the avocado is diverse and basically depends on its variety and maturation. They have a pleasant and slightly sweet aroma.

AVAILABILITY: in Colombia is practically throughout the year.
This makes the country one of the most attractive providers in the world.

Production areas: Coffee Region, Tolima, Antioquia, Cauca and Valle del Cauca.

Climate: It is a crop that develops very well at high altitudes, between 1,800 and 2,000 meters above sea level, likewise it develops well at a temperature of 5 to 17°C.

Average Brix degrees: 5.07 to 7.26%

Low average acidity: 19.47% to 9.24%

Average PH: 6.58 to 7.14

Average weight (g): 140 and 360
